COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

I. ELIGIBILITY

The Competition is open for students pursuing B.A.LL.B. (5 years), LL.B (3 years) Degree Course from any recognized Law College/University subject to fulfillment of the registration formalities, and must not exceed **25 years** of age on the date of holding the competition. Only one team will be permitted to participate from the College/Institution/University.

II. LANGUAGE: The Competition shall be conducted in the English language only.

III. TEAM COMPOSITION: Each team shall consist of three members, (Two Speakers and One Researcher).

IV. REGISTRATION: In order to confirm participation, teams of every Institution should register themselves. The registration process consists of the following steps:

• Each Team is required to fill and send Original Registration Form (along with Original Demand Draft & Authorization Letter through **Speed Post or Courier** latest by **17th October, 2019**. The envelope should be marked with **Dr. B.S Goel National Moot Court Competition, 2019**,

- The envelope should be send at the following address **IPEM Law Academy A-13/1, South Side G.T. Road Industrial Area, NH-24 By Pass, Ghaziabad, U.P.-201010.**
- The soft copy of registration form, demand draft details along with authorization letter be sent to **<moot2019@ipemgzb.ac.in>**. The details for Demand Draft transactions are given hereunder:

The Registration fee shall be Rs. 1500/-(Rupees One Thousand and Five Hundred only) for each participating team of 3 members (Two Speakers & one Researcher). No additional member shall be permitted.

The Demand Draft for Rs 1500/ shall be drawn in the favour of '**IPEM Law Academy, Payable at Ghaziabad.**

Forms received after the deadline i.e. **17th October, 2019** will not be considered for registration.

Change in Team Composition- Any change in team composition must be intimated to the Organizers at the earliest. Any change must be accompanied with a registration form and an authority letter duly signed by the head of the institution. No change in team composition is allowed after registration by post.

V. CRITERIA FOR MEMORIAL EVALUATION

Teams have to prepare Memorials for both the sides.

The teams must send soft copy of the Memorials and Counter Memorials latest by **10th November, 2019 before 11.59 p.m.** to **<moot2019@ipemgzb.ac.in>**, either in a pdf.or.doc or .docx format. In addition **6 (Six)** hard copies of the Memorials and counter memorials from each side should reach at the College Address latest by **15th November, 2019.**

VI. COMPETITIONS RULES AND REGULATIONS

Format of Memorials/ Counter Memorials

Color of the cover page must be **Blue** in case of **Petitioner** and **Red** in case of **Respondent**.

Body of Memorial shall include:

The cover Page of the memorial/ counter memorial must state the Cause Title

- 1. Table of Contents**
- 2. List of Abbreviations**
- 3. Index of Authorities/ Table of cases**
- 4. Statement of Jurisdiction**
- 5. Statement of Facts**
- 6. Statement of Issues**
- 7. Summary of Arguments**
- 8. Arguments advance/detailed argument**
- 9. Prayer**

The font of the body of the Memorial should be Times New Roman, size 12, line spacing 1.5 & headings should be 14. The font of the footnotes should be Times New Roman, size 10, line spacing Single.

Memorials should be spiral bound.

Memorial should have one inch margin on all sides of each page.

Page should be numbered at the bottom middle.

The Memorial shall be of a maximum of **40 pages** including the cover page and Pleadings/Arguments Advanced shall be of a maximum of **25 pages**. The memorial should not contain any photographs/sketches/exhibits/affidavits etc.

All memorials received within time schedule will be evaluated by the Memorial Evaluation Committee (MEC) to be constituted by the IPEM Law Academy, Ghaziabad.

The evaluation will be done on the following parameters

a. Knowledge of Facts & Law	20
b. Extent & use of research	20
c. Proper & Articulate Analysis	20
d. Clarity & Organization	10
e. Evidence of Original thought	10
f. Correct Format & Citation	10
g. Grammar & Style	10

Evaluation done by the MEC shall be final and binding

Note:

- ❖ Identity of the Institution should not be revealed anywhere in the memorial as well as in any Annexure.
- ❖ Violation of this provision will result in penalties including disqualification. The Organizer's decision shall be final in this regard. The memorials shall not contain any plagiarized material from any source.
- ❖ All references must be duly quoted in form of references/footnotes.
- ❖ No difference between Soft Copy and Hard Copy of Memorial: The hard copy of memorial must be exact replica of the soft copy submitted with the Organizers. Any difference in the same will result in disqualification from the Competition.

VII. ROUNDS

• Draw of lots

Each team will be provided with a Team Code on reporting to the venue. After the draw of lots, each team will be assigned a side (Petitioner or Appellant/Respondent). Fixtures of the team will be pre-determined based on the team codes.

- Rounds: The Competition is divided into
 - (1) Preliminary Rounds
 - (2) Quarter-Finals (if need be)
 - (3) Semi-Finals
 - (4) Finals

(1) Preliminary Rounds

Each team is allowed 12 minutes to represent their cases. Each team shall represent from both the sides. The winner of each court-room will be decided on the basis of the scores awarded by the judges in this round and the marks awarded by MEC.

Note: The results of the Preliminary Rounds shall be declared soon after the conclusion of the Preliminary Rounds. The top eight teams selected after this round will proceed to the Quarter-finals/Semi-Finals

(2) Quarter Finals

- (a) The top eight teams from the Preliminary Rounds will qualify for the quarters-finals.
- (b) The side for the quarter-finals shall be decided by ways of draws of lots.
- (c) The quarter-finals shall be a knock-out round.
- (d) The win-loss shall be decided on the basis of the aggregate speaker score.
- (e) Each team will get 15 minutes for arguing & 2 minutes for rebuttal.

(3) Semi-Finals

- (a) The top four teams from the Quarters-Finals will qualify for the Semi-Finals.
- (b) The side of the teams shall be decided by ways of draws of lots.
- (c) The Semi--Finals shall be a knock-out round.
- (d) The win-loss shall be decided on the basis of the aggregate speaker score.
- (e) Each team will get 15 minutes for arguing & 5 minutes for rebuttal.

(4) Finals

- (a) The top two teams selected after this round will proceed to the finals.
- (b) The side of the teams shall be decided by ways of draws of lots.
- (c) The win-loss shall be decided on the basis of the aggregate speaker score.
- (D) Each team will get 25 minutes for arguing & 5 minutes for rebuttal.

VIII. PROCEDURE AND MARKING OF COURT ROUNDS

The division of time per speaker is left to the discretion of the team.

The arguments should be confined to the issues presented in the memorial.

The researcher needs to be present with the speakers during all the rounds.

Maximum scores for the court rounds will be 100 marks per speaker. The court rounds will be judged on the following parameters:

a. Knowledge of Law	20
b. Application of law to facts	20
c. Ingenuity & ability to answer the questions	20
d. Style, Poise, Courtesy & Demeanor	20
e. Time Management	10
f. Organization	10

IX. DRESS CODE

Inside the Court Room the participants shall be in Formals.

Female(s): White Salwar and Kurta/White Shirt, Black Trouser and Black Tie along with Black Blazer and Black Shoes.

Boys: White Shirt, Black Trouser and Black Tie along with Black Blazer and Black Shoes.

X. Penalties

Scouting-Teams shall not be allowed to observe the orals of another team, unless they have been officially knocked-out of the competition. Scouting is strictly prohibited. Scouting by any team shall entail instant disqualification.

Non-Disclosure of Identity- It is mandatory for the teams that they should not disclose their identity, i.e. the name of the institution, city or any other information either in the submission of memorials (soft copy or hard copy) or elsewhere. Disclosing your identity leads to disqualification from the competition by the organizers.

Copyrights- It is mandatory for the participants to submit their Memorials in originality and the issue related to copyright should vest completely full to the organizers. The participants are solely responsible if any issue related to violation of copyrights in the form of plagiarism or exhibition of the materials.

The Organizers shall have the rights to publicly display, distribute either electronically or printed or otherwise and they shall not be liable to any person if any loss caused to person regarding collection of information or any accuracy, completeness or adequacy in the information contained in the materials which are published in future.

XI. AWARDS & PRIZES

- **Awards: The following awards shall be awarded in the Competition:**
 - a. Best Team:** The Team winning the final round of the Competition will get a Certificate, Trophy and a Cash Prize.
 - b. Runner Up-** The Runner Up team of the final round of the Competition will get a Certificate, Trophy and a Cash Prize.
 - c. Best Speaker-** Best Speaker award shall be determined on the basis of the total marks secured during the court rounds. The Speaker will get a Certificate, Trophy and Cash Prize.
 - d. Best Memorial:** The team having the highest average memorial score from both sides shall be given the Certificate, Memento and Cash Prize.
 - e. Best Researcher-** There shall be a Researcher test in the IPEM Law Academy and the Best Researcher will get Certificate, Memento and Cash Prize. The Researcher Test will be conducted on **30th November** from **10.00 A.M.**
 - f. Certificate of Participation shall be given to all the participating teams.**
- **The awards and certificate of participation shall be given during the valedictory ceremony to be conducted on 30th November, 2019. No certificate will be given to the team before or after the valedictory function.**

XII. ACCOMODATION AND FOOD

The Registration Fee includes complimentary breakfast, lunch and high tea for participants. Accommodation has to be borne by the participants itself only. No TA/DA will be given to the Participants.
